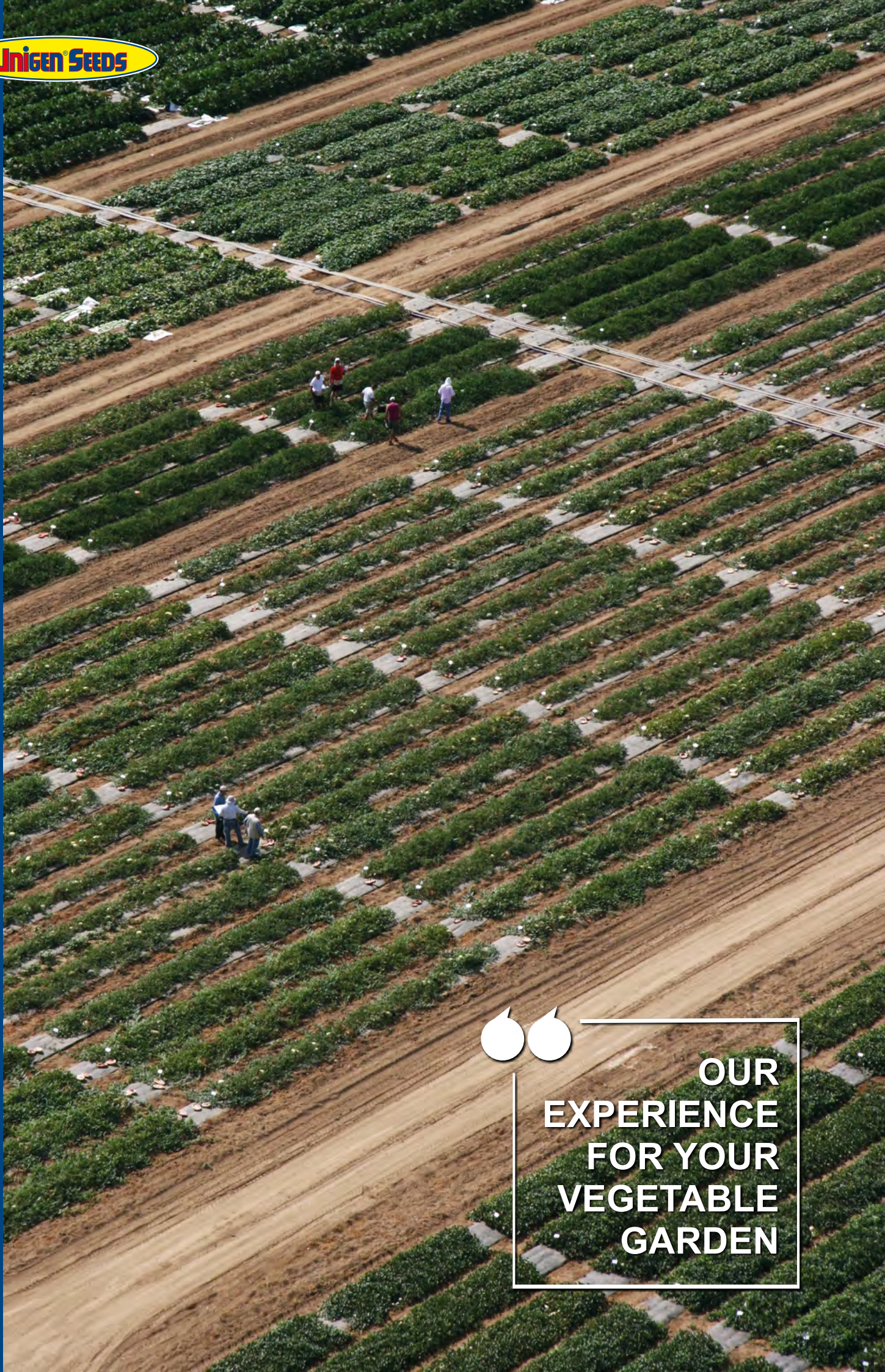

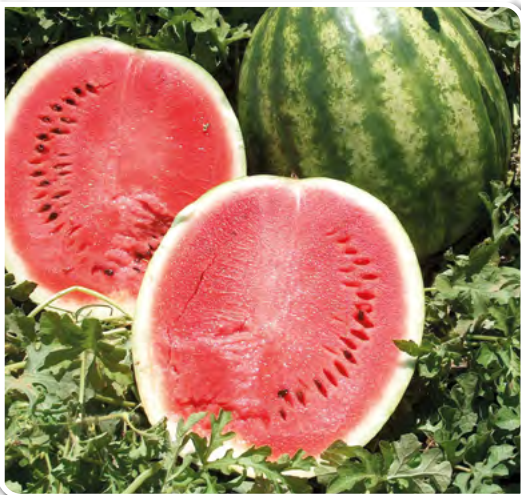

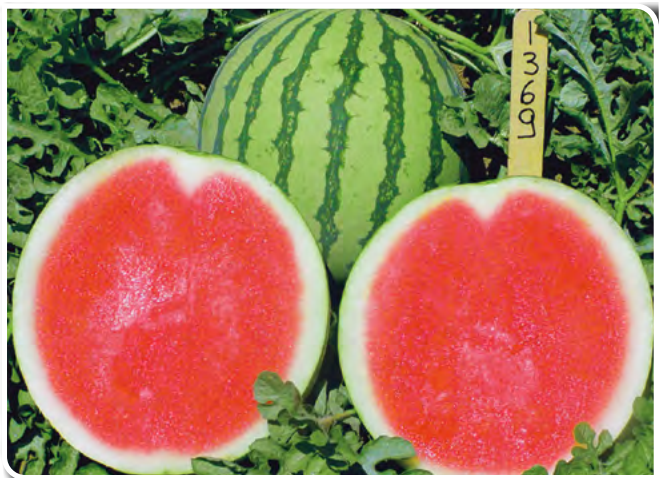


## YELLOW WIN

- Round fruits, average weight: 3-5 kg
- Yellow flesh with a sweet, intense flavour

## SINRUBITA

- Type: Seedless Miyako
- Early ripening
- Round fruits, average weight: 4-6 kg
- Excellent °Brix and flavour



## DOLLARITA

- Type: Crimson Seedless "Midi-Watermelon"
- Early ripening
- Round fruits, average weight: 4-5 kg
- Light green striped skin



## ESMERALDITA

- Type: Crimson Seedless "Midi-Watermelon"
- Very early ripening
- Round fruits, average weight: 4-5 kg
- Dark green striped skin





## UNCLE SAM

- Type: Honey Dew (Smooth)
  - Fertile plant with good leaf coverage.
  - Round, light green fruits that turn to creamy when ripe.
  - Salmon-coloured flesh and high °Brix.
- Average weight: 1.5-2.0 kg



## SWEET AMERICA

- Type: Italian Musk.
- Early ripening, good leaf coverage high yield.
- Netted skin fruits with green sutures, firm orange flesh.
- Average weight: 1.5-1.8 kg and high °Brix



## TUSCANY

- Type: Italian Musk
- Early ripening with vigorous, rustic, productive plants.
- Oval/round fruits, with good netting and well-defined sutures. Firm flesh, with a good aroma and smaller placenta cavity.
- Average weight: 1.5-1.8 kg and high sugar content.



## CHARMIEUX

- Type: Musk Charentais.
- Rustic, productive plant, very early maturing.
- Oval/round fruits, with fine netting and well-defined sutures, deep salmon-coloured flesh.
- Average weight: 1.1-1.3 kg and high °Brix



## OROGRANDE

- Type: Canary
- Early maturing plant and excellent yield.
- Oval-shaped fruits with slightly rough skin, golden yellow in colour. Sweet, aromatic, white flesh.
- Average weight: 2.0-2.5 kg and always high °Brix.

## FLAVORITE

- Type: Galia.
- Vigorous, early maturing plant.
- Oval fruits with orange skin when ripe. Firm flesh with a very small placenta cavity.
- Average weight: 1.5-2.0 kg and high sugar content.



## SAPOMIEL

- Type: "Piel de Sapo".
- Vigorous plant with good leaf coverage. Mid-early maturing.
- Elongated fruits with green skin, typical cracks and white flesh.
- Average weight: 2.5-3.0 kg and good shelf-life.



## UG 6931

- Type: "Kabocha".
- Fertile plant with excellent leaf coverage.
- Round fruits slightly dome-shaped. The skin is smooth and grey.
- The flesh is a deep salmon colour with a high sugar content.
- Very good for domestic use.

## DIAMANT

- Type: "Mid green".
- Mid-early cycle.
- Fertile plant with excellent leaf coverage.
- Uniform, cylindrical fruits with smooth, bright mid-green skin.



## DINASTY

- Type: "Dark green".
- Mid early, fertile plant with excellent leaf coverage.
- Uniform, cylindrical fruits with smooth bright dark green skin.
- IR: **ZYMV, Px**

## LONGZINI

- Type: "Greyzini".
- Fertile, upright, early maturing plant.
- Cylindrical fruits, with light green skin and deeper green stripes.
- IR: **ZYMV**



## SABAUDIO

- Type: "Mid green".
- Mid-early maturing, upright plant. Excellent yield.
- Uniform, cylindrical fruits with smooth, bright mid-green skin.
- IR: **ZYMV**.





## GREEN PICK

- Type: “Ginoico” industry cucumber.
- Compact plant with good leaf coverage and concentrated ripening.
- Dark green fruits with small white spines and very crunchy, light green-white flesh.
- Perfect for making pickles.

## GREEN SLAM

- Type: “Slicer” cucumber.
- Cylindrical, bright dark green fruits with a few white spines.  
Length: 18-20 cm and crunchy flesh.
- Slow seed development.



## MONTEBELLO

- Type: “Ginoico” cucumber.
- Very leafy, vigorous plant with good coverage and a high yield.
- Slightly spiny, cylindrical, dark green fruits.  
Length: 18-22 cm with a small placenta cavity and slow seed development.
- High organoleptic quality.

## UG 15CU05

- Type: “Long Dutch” cucumber.
- Mid-early maturing.
- Bright dark green fruits. Length: 25-30 cm, very uniform, straight with very few spines. Smooth, thin skin.
- Excellent digestibility.





## NITE LADY

- Type: Long & shiny black.
- Medium vigorous, mid-early maturing plant.
- Elongated-cylindrical fruits. Green spineless calyx.
- Good, constant yield over time.
- For Gh and of crop.

## BELLA ROMA

- Type: Romanesca.
- Medium vigorous plant with good leaf coverage.
- Round, light purple fruits with white flesh.  
dark purple seedless calix.
- Good yield, typically sweet flavour.



## GORDITA

- Type: Dark/Black Elongated Oval.
- Nicely vigorous plant, mid maturing with a high yield.
- Elongated oval, shiny black fruits with spineless green calyx.
- Good shelf-life after harvest.

## UG 7211

- Type: Light purple Striped.
- Nicely vigorous plant with a high potential yield.
- Elongated/oval, striped light purple fruits.  
Fleshy pulp and few seeds.
- Light green spineless calyx.





## GREENBOW

- Type: Broccoli.
- Mid-early maturing (70-75 days).
- Vigorous plant.
- Compact, uniform inflorescence.

## TALAMOND

- Type: Green cabbage.
- Early maturing (60-65 days)
- Regular, compact, round heads. Average weight: 1.5-2 kg.
- Well-wrapped, mid green leaves.



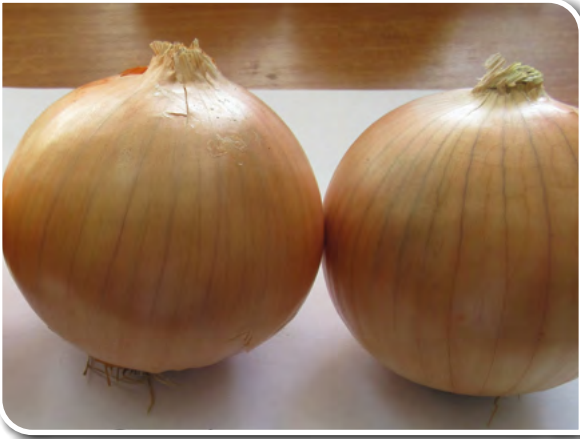
## RED HEAD

- Type: Red cabbage.
- Mid-early maturing (70-75 days)
- Regular, compact, round heads. Average weight: 1.5-2 kg.
- Deep red colour and a high specific weight.

## SAVOSTAR

- Type: Semi-bullate savoy cabbage.
- Mid-early maturing (70-75 days)
- Regular, compact, round heads. Average weight: 1.5-2 kg.
- Light blue-green leaves with good coverage.





## DORYAN

- Type: Dark Yellow/Bronze, long day onion.
- Spring sowing in Long Day Regions. Mid maturing.
- Nice round uniform bulbs, dark yellow in colour, almost brown.
- Excellent yield and storage.



## SUNKEY

- Type: Yellow short day onion.
- Autumn sowing in Northern region (Overwintering)
- Mid maturing with sowing in autumn.
- Round/spherical yellow bulbs with an excellent uniform size.
- Very good yield and shelf-life. Mid storage.



## RED PRIMEUR

- Type: Red short day onion.
- Mid maturing with sowing in autumn and a healthy, vigorous plant.
- For Overwintering crop.
- Round, red bulbs with a sweet flavour and an excellent uniform size.
- Good shelf-life after harvest.

## BEST OF WHITE

- Type: White long day onion.
- Spring sowing in Long Day Regions.
- Mid-early maturing.
- Round uniform, bulb, well dressed. Bright white bulbs no greenish.
- Excellent shelf-life.





## HABANERO UGI 5916

- Type: Yellow “Habanero”.
- Rustic vigorous plant with good leaf coverage.
- Bright Yellow fruits with a typical uniform shape
- Very pungent.
- Classic aroma for making typical tropical dishes.



## HABAHOT

- Type: Red “Habanero”.
- Robust plant with a high yield and also suitable for extended harvests.
- Red fruits with a typical uniform shape; very pungent.
- Classic aroma for making typical tropical dishes.



## PINOCCHIO

- Type: “Cayenne”.
- Mid maturing, Rustic plant with a high yield, recommended for open fields.
- Bright red thin walls, very good for drying. Length: 30-40 cm. Great for eating fresh when green very tasty aroma.
- HR: **Tm:0**  
IR: **TSWV**



## BALRAM

- Type: Indian type “Cayenne”.
- Medium vigorous, rustic plant. Upright habit and short internodes.
- Thin, tapered, bright coloured very pungent fruit. Length: 8-10 cm.
- Excellent prolonged yield.



## EROICO

- Type: "Hot Banana".
- Vigorous plant with a high yield, perfect for extended harvests.
- Uniform, yellow greenish to red fruits when fully ripe. Good thick walls. 3/4 cm shoulder and 18-20 cm in length, very spicy when fully ripe. To make paste.
- HR: **Tm:0**



## ANAGIANT

- Type: "Anaheim"
- Medium vigorous, early maturing, with a high potential yield.
- Very uniform, bilobed conical-shaped fruits, mid green, turn to red when fully ripe. Average weight: 100-130 g. Mid-hot when green, make them perfect for eating fresh. For paste when red.
- HR: **Tm:0**  
IR: **TSWV**



## PICADERO

- Type: "Jalapeño". Classic Mexican pepper.
- Strong, vigorous plant with a high yield
- Mid green fruits that turn red when fully ripe. Length: 9-11 cm and average weight: 70-80 g. Very spicy when fully ripe.
- HR: **Xcv**



## CHERRY FIRE

- Type: "Cherry".
- Medium vigorous, rustic plant. Easy to harvest.
- Round deep cherry fruits, shiny green, turn deep red when fully ripe. Medium/small size. Perfect for stuffed chilli peppers.
- HR: **Tm:0**



## OROSTAR

- Type: Yellow “Blocky”. For protected and OF.
- Nicely vigorous, rustic plant, short internodes. Up-right fruits, easy picking.
- Bright yellow, early turning to yellow. Good thick wall, high specific weight.
- Good size and excellent yield.
- HR: **Tm:0/Xcv**  
IR: **TSWV**

## VERGARO

- Type: Red “Square”.
- Compact, rustic plant with a high yield. For open fields and protected crop.
- Uniform, red fruits with smooth skin and thick flesh.
- HR: **Tm:0/Xcv**



## GOLDEN IMPERATOR

- Type: Yellow “Lamuyo”. For protected and OF.
- Mid maturing: strong plant with excellent leaf coverage.
- Uniform, yellow fruits with good thick flesh. Medium/large size.
- HR: **Tm:0/PVY**

## RED IMPERATOR

- Type: Red “Lamuyo”.
- Very vigorous, mid-early maturing plant with excellent leaf coverage, for open fields.
- Uniform, red fruits with good thick flesh. Medium/large size.
- HR: **Tm:0/PVY**





## ADRIATICO

- Type: "Pescarese/Marconi".
- Med-vigor, rustic plant with excellent leaf coverage.
- Uniform, straight, deep red fruits with two or three lobes and quite heavy.
- Suitable for protected and open fields crop.
- HR: **Tm:0**  
IR: **TSWV**

## NAPOLINO

- Type: "Friariello" mini-pepper.
- Vigorous plant, very early maturing, high yield.
- Uniform, conical fruits, 2-3 cm wide and 6-8 cm high.
- For open fields and protected crop.
- HR: **Tm:0**  
IR: **TSWV**



## CALABRESE

- Type: "Tomato pepper".
- Medium vigorous, rustic plant. Early ripening with a high yield.
- Sweet, flattened round fruits with good ribbed. Excellent thick flesh. Very bright Red, inside and outside. For fresh, pickling and processing for paste.
- For protected and open fields crop.
- HR: **Tm:0**  
IR: **TSWV**

## YELLOWBAR

- Type: Yellow "Horn" shape.
- Mid maturing plant. Very rustic and high yield. For protected and open fields crop.
- Regular, heavy, large-sized fruits. Excellent thick walls. Smooth, deep green skin, turns to attractive bright yellow.
- HR: **Tm:0/Xcv**  
IR: **TSWV**







## UGI 3171-17

- Type: "Mini Plum, Tiger Brown" type.
- Strong, productive, mid-early maturing. For protected crop in spring or summer.
- Very consistent, uniform fruits with an extraordinary red striped brown colour, when fully ripe. High °Brix, 9-10°, average weight: 20-25 g.
- HR: **ToMV/VaVd/Fol:0-1**  
IR: **MaMiMj**.



## INDIANITO

- Type: "Datterino".
- Mid maturing. Strong plant with a high yield.
- Sweet, deep red fruits, average weight of 18-20 g. Well-formed and very uniform clusters.
- For harvesting either in cluster or single fruits.
- HR: **ToMV/VaVd/Fol:0-1**  
IR: **MaMiMj**



## CINZANO

- Type: "Cherry/mini cocktail".
- Vigorous plant with an excellent yield. Suitable for protected crop.
- Very consistent, uniform, round fruits. Average weight: 20-25 g. Elegant, very uniform cluster.
- HR: **ToMV/VaVd/Fol:0-1/Pf:A-E**  
IR: **TYLCV/Pn/Lt**



## ORANGE MAKO

- Type: Orange “Cherry/mini cocktail”.
- Vigorous, productive plant, mid-early maturing.
- Uniform, orange fruits with an extraordinary aroma. High °Brix 8-9°. Average weight: 20-25 g.
- HR: **ToMV/Fol:0-1**

## MONCHERRY 2000

- Type: “Cherry”.
- Mid-early maturing. Good vigor plant with an high yield.
- Mid green colour that turns bright red when fully ripe.
- 12-15 fruits/cluster, with a rachis resistant to destemming. Typical, very sweet flavour.
- HR: **ToMV/VaVd/Fol:0-1**  
IR: **MaMiMj**



## ZUCHELLO

- Type: “Midi-Plum/Cocktail”.
- Vigorous plant very productive, mid-early maturing. Intense flavour.
- Uniform cluster. Average weight of 25/30 g and high Brix. It turns red on uniform way all cluster. Can be harvested either in cluster or single fruits.
- HR: **ToMV/VaVd/Fol:0-1**  
IR: **MaMiMj**

## VALLETTO

- Type: “Midi Plum”.
- Medium vigorous plant, mid-early maturing with a good potential yield.
- Very consistent, uniform fruits. Average weight: 30-35 g, good °Brix.
- HR: **ToMV/VaVd/Fol:0-1/Pf:A-E**  
IR: **TSWV/ MaMiMj**





## UGI 1852-16

- Type: "Marmande".
- Vigorous, rustic plant. Deep green with impressive color when turning.
- Uniform, fruits, quite firm also when fully ripe.
- HR: **ToMV/Pf:A-E/VaVd**  
IR: **Pn**

## BATON ROUGE 030

- Type: "Saladette".
- Nicely vigorous, indeterminate very prolific plant, with good leaf coverage, suitable for extended harvests.
- Fruit: average weight of 100-120 g, very consistent, juicy, 5-6 fruits per cluster.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1**  
IR: **MaMiMj**



## MONTALBAN

- Type: "Insalataro" classic.
- The plant is vigorous, with medium-short internodes and good leaf coverage. Growth stops at the 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> truss.
- Globe fruits, average weight: 250-350 g. Flavourful, juicy "full" flesh when fully red.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1/Aal**

## UGI 1108-15

- Type: "Insalataro".
- Plant with short internodes and good coverage. Excellent production.
- Medium-small, smooth, round fruits (80-90 g), with a "Camone"-style green shoulder. Best harvest when turning colour. Deep red colour due to lycopene content.
- HR: **ToMV/TYLCV/Pf A-E/Pn/Fol 0-1**





## CENTAURO

- Type: "Insalataro".
- Plant with short internodes and good coverage. Excellent production.
- Large, flattening, multilocular fruits (250-350 g), bright red in colour when fully ripe.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1/Pst**  
IR: **TYLCV/TSWV/MaMiMj**

## PORTUGUES

- Type: Ribbed "Beef".
- Vigorous plant, mid-early maturing plant with a high yield.
- Large fruits (300-400 g) with strong ribbed segments, mid green colour, turns deep pink when ripe.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1**  
IR: **TSWV/ MaMiMj**



## SUPERMARZANO

- Type: "San Marzano classic".
- Medium vigorous, rustic, plant. Early ripening.
- Typical elongated San Marzano fruits, the colour is mid green turn to deep red when fully ripe. Juice and sweet. Average weight: 130-140 g.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1**  
IR: **MaMiMj**

## SANREMO #2

- Type: "Oxheart".
- Vigorous good setting plant also on the higher trusses. Early maturing.
- The fruits have an average weight of 250-300 g, mid green with very attractive dark green stripes. Turn bright pink and then deep red.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1**  
IR: **TSWV/ MaMiMj**





## FAIR LADY

- Type: "Insalataro" LSL.
- Vigorous, compact plant with good coverage, mid maturing.
- Very consistent, uniform fruits with excellent resistance to over-ripening. (Long Shelf-Life). Average weight: 200-250 g.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1/Aal**

## RIO ORO

- Type: "Saladette".
- Medium vigorous, rustic plant. Early maturing with a high yield.
- Elongated/square fruits. Firm and deep red colour. Average weight: 100-120 g.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1/Pst**  
IR: **MaMiMj**



## GIGANTICO

- Type: "Saladette".
- Early and nicely vigorous plant with good leaf coverage.
- Very uniform, consistent fruits with good field storage. Average weight: 110-130 g.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1/Pst**  
IR: **MaMiMj**



## CILENTO

- Type: "Elongated".
- Nicely vigorous, rustic plant.
- Firm, uniform red fruits.
- Classic shape, for fresh, processing and sun-dry.
- Average weight: 90-110 g.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1/Pst**  
IR: **MaMiMj**

## CILIEGINO 2000

- Type: "Cherry".
- The plant is determinate, vigorous, with short internodes and good leaf coverage.
- Uniform, deep red fruits.
- Average weight: 15-20 g.  
Excellent cracks resistance.  
Good bx and flavour.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1/Aal**



## FRASSINO

- Type: "Pizzutello" traditional.
- Vigorous, compact plant with a very high yield.
- Fruits with the classic "little nipple" on the tradition, deep red in colour.  
Average weight: 15-20 g.
- HR: **VaVd/Fol:0-1/Pst**  
IR: **TSWV/MaMiMj**
